Paul Denham added a spring controlled fly ball governor to his Wyvern made from Dwight's castings.



Paul also had a Hercules 2 cylinder engine running after some rework.


BITS AND PIECES




Jim Freel and Jerry Franklin are building Silver Angel engines designed by Bob Shore. Jerry turned
