I requested loan of fire extinguishers from anyone that has currently certified five-pound units. A sign-up sheet was started for those that wanted to volunteer to help with the show before, during or after. The list is on the last page of this report.

Tom Hare talked about contacts with other clubs with publicity for the show. He talked about the supply of half-sheet fliers and the distribution of them to hobby shops.

### **Tech Topics**

Dwight Giles talked about his activity in making drawings of an 8 HP Hicks marine engine. The engine has a 6.5" bore and operates at 120 to 520 RPM. It has a 2.5" valves with 12" stem. Dwight has the engine on loan. Anyone wishing to see the engine run, should contact Dwight. He has made a number of hand drawn sketches which are quite challenging. "You have to look at everything when you draw the engine" he says. He plans to use ALIBRE to create his final drawings.

Don Jones is also making drawings of the engine using Solidworks.
